**Note on Impregnating Sealers:**

Impregnating sealers repel most water and oil based contaminants, having little effect on the tiles' frictional properties and appearance. Impregnating sealers work along a similar principle to 'fabric protection' or 'Scotchguarding'. They will hold water and staining materials in suspension for a short period of time to allow immediate clean-up. They won't prevent surface etching caused by acid aggression (e.g. lemon, vinegar etc). Simply, impregnating sealers in conjunction with regular cleaning, ensure an efficient floor management system.
